

**Minutes of the Meeting of the Third-Party Aggregator (TPA) Meet conducted on 24/04/2025 in the “Smart Room” of BOPT(ER), Kolkata.**

A workshop of the Third-Party Aggregator (TPA) in the Eastern Region was conducted on 24/04/2025 in the “Smart Room” of BOPT(ER) Kolkata. Directors/CEOs/ Representatives from 42 out of 40 empaneled TPAs in the Eastern Region attended the meeting. The list of invitees attended the meeting is enclosed herewith.

At the outset, the Director, BOPT(ER) welcomed all the participants and took up the agenda for discussion as mentioned below:

Action taken on the resolution of the previous TPA meeting held on 19/12/2024. The minutes of the meeting of the TPA conducted on 19/12/2024 was discussed in detail to ascertain the action taken on the resolutions adopted in the said meeting.

1. The performance of TPA partners for forth quarter F.Y 2024-25 was perused by all the participants. It was found that except M/s Spectrum Talent Management, M/s. 2COMS Consulting Pvt. Ltd., M/s. Orion Edutech Pvt. Ltd. , M/s. Ascent Academy of Training and Development Pvt. Ltd. & M/s. Kampabhai Vocational Training Institute all other TPA partners’ performance was un-satisfactorily. A detailed discussion was held on the subject, and it was decided that the target has been fixed for all TPA partners of the F.Y. 2025-2026.
2. For the Financial Year 2025-26 all TPA Partners will focus on those big sectors who have not yet engaged in NATS i.e., Hospitality Sector, Tourism Sector, Hotels, Nursing Institute, Retail Sector, Telecom Sector etc.

At the time of Engagement of the Establishment one of two criteria must be considered i.e., “Regional presence of the Establishment or PAN India presence of the establishment”.

3. All TPA partners must ensure that at the time of CoA creation the gap between date of creation of contract and date of joining must not exceed 15 days.
4. The credentials and the data furnished against the establishment must be thoroughly checked / verified before submission.
5. All TPAs ensure updated Profile & updated report on the TPA portal.
6. Those TPAs who have not submitted PAN India letter yet for the PAN India compliance company wise must submit those letters to the respective Sections & Officers (hard copies) by email or post.
7. All the TPAs must organise one Industry Academia Interaction Programme or industry meet on quarterly basis without fail.
8. It was also found that each TPA partner was supposed to conduct one programme in each quarter at different places in eastern region on the topic of “Up-skilling of Current Training Facilities Under NATS”. Most of the TPA Partners have failed to conduct such programmes.
9. All the TPAs are informed that for Direct Beneficiary Transfer, ROP should be updated every month.

10. A detailed discussion was held on how to mobilize students. Every year a large number of fresh pass out students get admission in college out of which less than 10 per cent students enrolled in NATS. Therefore, institutes need to be included in your mobilization Programme.
11. Every TPA partner should register at least three establishments on ACJF Portal for the Mega Apprenticeship-cum-Job Fair, which will be organized in Bihar on 30.05.2025 and 31.05.2025.
12. All TPA Partners are informed that they should share information to the respective officer on new establishment whenever it is onboarding on Portal.
