

REGIONAL APPRENTICESHIP DAY: 2023


Introduction:

Board of Practical Training (Eastern Region), Kolkata is an autonomous organization of the Ministry of Education (erstwhile Ministry of Human Resource Development), Department of Higher Education, Govt. of India established in the year 1968. The Board is performing its responsibilities of proper implementation of the Apprenticeship Act,1961 as amended time to time in the Eastern Region comprising states of West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, Assam, Nagaland, Manipur, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Sikkim, and Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. In accordance with the Apprenticeship Act and Rules, the board is empowered to access Apprenticeship Training facilities for Graduates & Diploma Holders in Engineering & Technology and Graduates in General Stream pass outs as Graduate and Technician apprentices under the Apprentices (Amendment) Act,2014 in respect of establishments/industries under various sectors, notify them to engage stipulated number of apprentices, oversee engagement of apprentices, monitor, and review the working of the Apprenticeship Training Scheme (both quantitatively and qualitatively). The responsibility of the Board also includes reimbursement of Central Governments' share of stipend at the rate of 50% on minimum prescribed rate claimed by the Training Establishments after registration of contract of Apprenticeship.

In order to provide on the job training (OJT) to the freshly pass out Graduates & Diploma Holders in Engineering & Technology and Graduate in General Stream students such as B.A., B.Sc., B. Com. etc. in an organized and effective manner, BOPT(ER) implement National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) through national web portal (www.mhrdnats.gov.in) and regional web portal (www.portalbopter.com) facilitating all the stakeholders like Establishments/Industries, Third Party Aggregators (TPA), Students and Institutions.

Over the 50 years, BOPT(ER) achieved tremendous success on this by providing apprenticeship training to more than 15 lakhs students in association with more than 3 thousand industries in Eastern Region.

In this Backdrop. The competent authority of BOPT(ER), Kolkata has decided to honor our top 4 esteemed stakeholders i.e., Establishments/Industries, Third Party Aggregators (TPA), Students and Institutions from 13 states of Eastern Region on the following categories on Regional Apprenticeship Day, 2023 which is going to be celebrated on 02/09/2023 (Saturday).




Objectives:

3. Recognition for the contribution of the Establishments, Institutions & Students in NATS/ Regional portal during the year.
4. Minimizing the gap between Industries and Academia by developing effective establishment institution interactions.

A certificate and a Memento of Accomplishment will be provided to the best among each category of the following:

1. Establishment of the Year
2. Institution of the Year
3. Apprentice of the Year
4. Third Party Aggregator (TPA) of the Year

Overall Procedure for the Selection of the Awardee:




**** After shortlisting, you will be invited for presenting your achievement at BOPT(ER), Kolkata premises on the Scheduled date and time.**

Eligibility for Nomination:

- A. For establishments – An establishment/organization who registered in NATS portal (www.mhrdnats.gov.in) or Regional Web Portal (www.portalbopter.com) and engaging apprentices of minimum 2.5% of total manpower (including contractual, casual & outsourced staffs) in the last 3 financial years is eligible to file their nomination.
- B. For Apprentices – An apprentice who have completed his/her apprenticeship training in last financial year by maintaining minimum 60% of attendance at workplace and having a Certificate of Proficiency (COP) generated through NATS Portal (www.mhrdnats.gov.in) or Regional Web Portal (www.portalbopter.com) only can apply.
- C. For institutions – An Institution who has updated its profile in NATS portal (www.mhrdnats.gov.in) or Regional Web Portal (www.portalbopter.com) and at least 05 passed out students of that institute placed for apprenticeship training in any NATS registered establishment in the last financial year, only can apply.

How to Submit Online Nomination



Time period for consideration:

Performance during the financial year 2022-23 (01/04/2022 to 31/03/2023) will take into the consideration for the selection of the awardee.

Date of submission of Online Nomination:

Online Nomination for the Regional Apprenticeship Day 2023 will Start from 15/05/2023 and end on 30/06/2023.

Shortlisting of Nomination and Selection of Awardee:

A selection committee headed by Dy. Director, BOPT(ER) will recommend the names of the awardee from the nominated list after presentation of nominees in front of the following jury members as follows:

Decision taken by the above jury members regarding selection of the Winner of all the categories will be final.
